### **CSLF Provides Simplified CommonLine File Exchanges through EnRoute**

**Rocky Hill, CT – March 25, 2002** – CSLF Student Loan Foundation (CSLF) recently announced the release of EnRoute Version 2.14. EnRoute, CSLF’s internet-based loan processing and management system, now allows schools to exchange CommonLine files with multiple agencies through a single file exchange with CSLF.

EnRoute users simply send to CSLF a single CommonLine file with loan records for multiple destinations. CSLF separates the loan records by destination and sends a split out file to the appropriate service providers. CSLF then collects all responses from the service providers and places them on EnRoute for download. Schools no longer need to separate loan records by destination or maintain destination addresses for all of their service providers. All records are sent and received through a single product, EnRoute.

“This enhancement to EnRoute underscores our commitment to provide the best possible products, services and technology to our customers,” said Mark Valenti, President of CSLF. “EnRoute not only simplifies file exchanges between destination points, it simplifies the entire loan process for schools by providing a single product for all loan guarantee and servicing processes for the life of the loan. I am very pleased with EnRoute. Based on the responses from our customers and the number of users we have, EnRoute is not only a huge success but a product of the future,” Valenti said.

CSLF uses Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology to ensure that file uploads and downloads to EnRoute are secure. Files exchanged between EnRoute and service providers are securely transmitted using NCHelp encryption standards.

EnRoute provides users with a record of all CommonLine File Transfers (uploads and downloads) between CSLF and the school. All file exchanges, including the individual split out files to the various destination points, are recorded and can be opened to view the detail. EnRoute also allows schools to reschedule files for download through the CommonLine File Transfer Log.
